

#### PACKAGE SUPPLIED

#### DO's



Follow all instructions. Keep these instructions. Heed all warnings.

To avoid tearing when replacing the hand skin, you can apply talc to the inside, this will prevent friction occurring when fitting the hand skin.



If a product is damaged or worn, it should be repaired by Limbs & Things. To arrange this, please contact your point of purchase who will be able to provide a repair quote.

Clean the product with a damp soft cloth or sponge, using only warm water with mild detergent, after every training session.



Take care when removing cast so not to damage the skin

Tension must be set back to 0 (lowest tension) when product is not in use.



#### **DON'Ts**



Do not install near any heat sources, do not expose the product to flames or use near naked flame sources. Do not use flammable solvents near or on this product.

Do not use any attachments other than those supplied by the manufacturer.





Apart from hand skin removal, do not disassemble the product or attempt to repair a faulty unit, please return the product to Limbs & Things for assessment and repair.

Do not allow young children to use this product.





Stand not to be pulled on with force while training.

Do not inject liquid into the product, it is not intended for anaesthetic injections.




SET UP

The product is ready to use out of the box.




An adjustable tension feature allows for progressive levels of difficulty.

The stand provides a fixed reference point.




Product to always be used with a minimum of two people, conducting traction and counter traction, even when using the stand


Numerous plastering techniques can be performed.

#### REPLACING THE HAND SKIN

Remove the 3 screws.



Remove the skin securing plate.




#### REPLACING THE HAND SKIN



To replace the skin, reverse this process.

Take particular care when first inserting arm skin over the forearm.



CLEANING & STORAGE

Clean off any surface dirt with a damp, soft cloth, using only warm water and mild detergent.
